 - 16/05358/CTREE - The Old Parsonage, Frieth Hill, Frieth** - APPLICATION FOR: Reduce T1 Horse Chestnut by approximately 5 metres / 20%; fell T3 and T5 Horse Chestnut; reduce T4 and T6 Ash by approximately 5 metres to the same height as T1; deadwood T7 and T8 Horse Chestnut and reduce limbs on house side by approximately 3 metres, and balance crown; deadwood T9 Sycamore and reduce limbs on house side by approximately 3 metres, and balance crown; reduce T10 Ash by 2-3 metres / 10%, remove over-extended limbs, and deadwood; remove deadwood from T11 Sycamore; fell T12 Horse Chestnut; raise canopy of T13 Horse Chestnut by up to 5-6 metres on roadside and less inside garden, and remove deadwood; fell T14 Ash; lightly reshape T15 Sycamore by reducing by up to 3 metres.
