 - 13/05851/FUL-Birch Cottage, Bottom Hill, Hambleden** -Householder application for levelling of parking area with retaining wooden supports walls for Birch Cottage (retrospective)
 - 13/05869/CTREE-The Old Crown House, Skirmett** -Crown reduction of between approximately 1 1/2 - 2 metres and reshape to provide clearance from telephone pole to Magnolia.
 - 13/05867/CTREE-Flint Cottage, Frieth Hill, Frieth** -Crown thin up to 15% to T0 Acer campestre; crown thin up to 15% & remove basal epicormic growth to T1 Acer campestre; crown thin up to 5% to T4 Ilex aquifolium; crown spread reduction up to 5% to T5 Abies grandis, T8 & T9 Chamaecyparis; crown thin up to 10% and crown spread reduction up to 5% to T12 Picea; crown spread reduction by up to 20% and crown thin up to 10% to T13 Malus sylvestris; crown thin up to 5% to T14 & T15 Ilex aquifolium; fell T3 Prunus laurocerasus, T6 (Cupressus), T7(Abies), T10 &T11(Chamaecyparis), T16 (Cupressocyparis) and T19 (Acer psuedoplatanus).  - 13/05800/FUL & 13/05801/LBC-The Manor House, Hambleden Village** - Householder application for single storey side/rear extension, single storey rear infill extension & single storey side extension with creation of gymnasium and plant room in basement. Internal and external alterations and replacements, to include improved circulation arrangements through the Central (east-west) Corridor, lowering of the Kitchen Pantry floor, alterations to 3 no. existing window openings to form external door-ways, improvements to the Master Suite, improvements to the layout of bedrooms to the first and second floors and the formation of a new Gun Room within the existing Laundry area
