17/05888/LBC – The Hyde & Stonylands Bagmoor Lane Hambleden – Listed building application for construction of single storey rear extension, internal layout alterations and external fenestration alterations to main dwellinghouse, garage and outbuildings and alterations to parking/turning serving The Hyde and construction of new detached greenhouse, new driveway and parking area to serve Stonylands

17/05887/FUL – The Hyde & Stonylands Bagmoor Lane Hambleden – Householder application for construction of single storey rear extension, internal layout alterations and external fenestration alterations to main dwellinghouse, garage and outbuildings and alterations to parking/turning serving The Hyde and construction of new detached greenhouse, new driveway and parking area to serve Stonylands

17/05779/TPO – Bramble Lodge Colstrop Lane Hambleden – Trim back Yew trees by 3-4 metres overhanging Colstrop Lane & reduce height of Ash saplings to 1 metre in height which are undermining telephone wires, tidy up branch stubs left from squirrel damage to 1 Beech tree & damage from goods vehicles to 1 Yew tree & remove three dead Wych Elms

17/06037/CTREE – The New House Frieth Hill Frieth – Reduce by approx 3m to roof ridge level to reduce excessive shading and over growth to 1 x Sycamore Tree (T1)

17/05932/FUL – Greenlands Henley Road Hambleden – removal of existing boundary fencing and gates and replace with 2m high acoustic fencing and various gates
